

NOVA Chat 10





NOVA chat is a communication system that offers Chat software on a 10" android platform.

Size of grid varies from a very simple 4 grid to more complex communication grids. A combination of words and symbols are used on the larger grids.

Clients should generally have a good knowledge of symbols and/or written words, be able to categorise and navigate around a low tech system before a high tech system like this would be considered.

- Top 3 messages are the same on each level and should be things that are needed the most e.g. toilet, help, hello

- This is recorded speech so all the messages to be accessed will need to be recorded prior to giving it to the client.

Step Pad

Doo-zy switch 000010





- Recordable switching communicator
- Manual, carrying case, adaptor and cable
- Doo-zy can be accessed directly through touch or by proximity
- Additional feedback can be given by the switch using vibration and/or lights
- Has multiple uses e.g. switch, recorder, infra red remote, toy controller, environmental control

Etran Frame



- Serial no 0000119 (2 different layouts) and Stand
- Eye pointing is potentially a simple and useful way of communicating for people who cannot physically access other systems.
- The ETRAN frame can be used with photos, symbols or even objects for communication.

Switches

Switches can be used to help someone with physical difficulties access a variety of things within their environment such as toys, lights, music, food mixers.

Some items can be purchased already switch adapted but others would need battery adaptors/mains controller/click-on to facilitate this.

Assessment would need to be undertaken with your service user to decide which switch best meets their needs.

Switches vary greatly in size and access method. A range of these are available through the AAC kit in your area.

Switch Latch and Timer





- This is great for a person using a single battery operated device
- There are 3 modes of control that determine how much time the device operates for once the switch is activated minutes, seconds, on/off

Click-On



- This is a mains controller. It can operate two mains devices at the same time.
- It has different options available for operating the selected object/toy.
