Who is a carer

A carer is someone of any age who looks after and supports a relative or friend who, because of their disability, illness, frailty or addiction, would not otherwise be able to live independently at home.

Many carers provide substantial amounts of regular care and are not paid for the help and support that they give. Caring for someone can be very stressful. Carers often have little help and regularly suffer financially, physically and emotionally themselves.

Carers of West Dunbartonshire is an independent, voluntary organisation which is managed by a voluntary Board of Directors.

The service works in partnership with West Dunbartonshire Council and West Dunbartonshire Community Health & Care Partnership.

The Carers' Centre at 84 Dumbarton Road,

service is managed. We are open from 9.30 a.m.
to 4.30 p.m. Monday to Friday and carers who
reside in any part of West Dunbartonshire are
welcome to access our services any time
during those hours.
