## WHO IS THE SERVICE FOR?

The service is available to anyone in the West Dunbartonshire area who is Blind or partially sighted or who is Deaf, deafblind or hard of hearing, including their families.



## HOW TO ASK FOR SERVICES

You or someone acting on your behalf can contact your local Health and Social Care Partnership office – details at the back of this leaflet. You can telephone 01389 776499 or call in to your local office and ask to be referred to the Sensory Impairment Team.

## WHO ARE THE SENSORY IMPAIRMENT TEAM

The team is made up of a rehabilitation officer, 2 social workers and a resource worker who specialise in carrying out assessments and identifying areas of difficulty for you.

## What services does the team offer?

A member of the team will work with you to identify your needs and will help identify areas where you may need, or wish to have, support. These may include the following:

- Assessing for and providing appropriate equipment to assist you with daily living and providing training in how to use it.
- Developing your independent living skills.
- Providing mobility training to increase/develop safe and independent movement both indoors and out.
- Giving you and your carers advice and support.
- Providing information on other useful organisations.
