

West Dunbartonshire ADP: Justice Setting Working Group - Delivery Plan, September 2020

- This Delivery Plan supplements the ADP Strategy 2020-2025 and will contribute to the future Community Justice Outcome Improvement Plan 2021 onwards (reported via the Community Planning West Dunbartonshire Safe Delivery and Improvement Group).
- This Delivery Plan outlines the local contribution to achieving national outcomes outlined in :
 - Rights Respect and Recovery (RRR): A Public Health Approach to Justice. Outcome: Vulnerable people are diverted from the justice system wherever possible and those within justice settings are fully supported.  - ADP Ministerial Priority 3: A public health approach to justice for alcohol and drugs
 - Identify the investment, outcomes and outputs delivered by alcohol and drug services which act as a diversion measure from justice including those services which work with people as a condition of sentence, in prison or leaving prison / voluntary through care.
 - Develop improvement plans as needed
- The activity within this Delivery Plan will be performance managed through the West Dunbartonshire Council Performance Management System, Pentana, with quarterly reports submitted to each ADP meeting.
- Timescales have been updated to reflect COVID-19 recovery priorities and resources available.
- The Delivery Plan will be refreshed annually.
